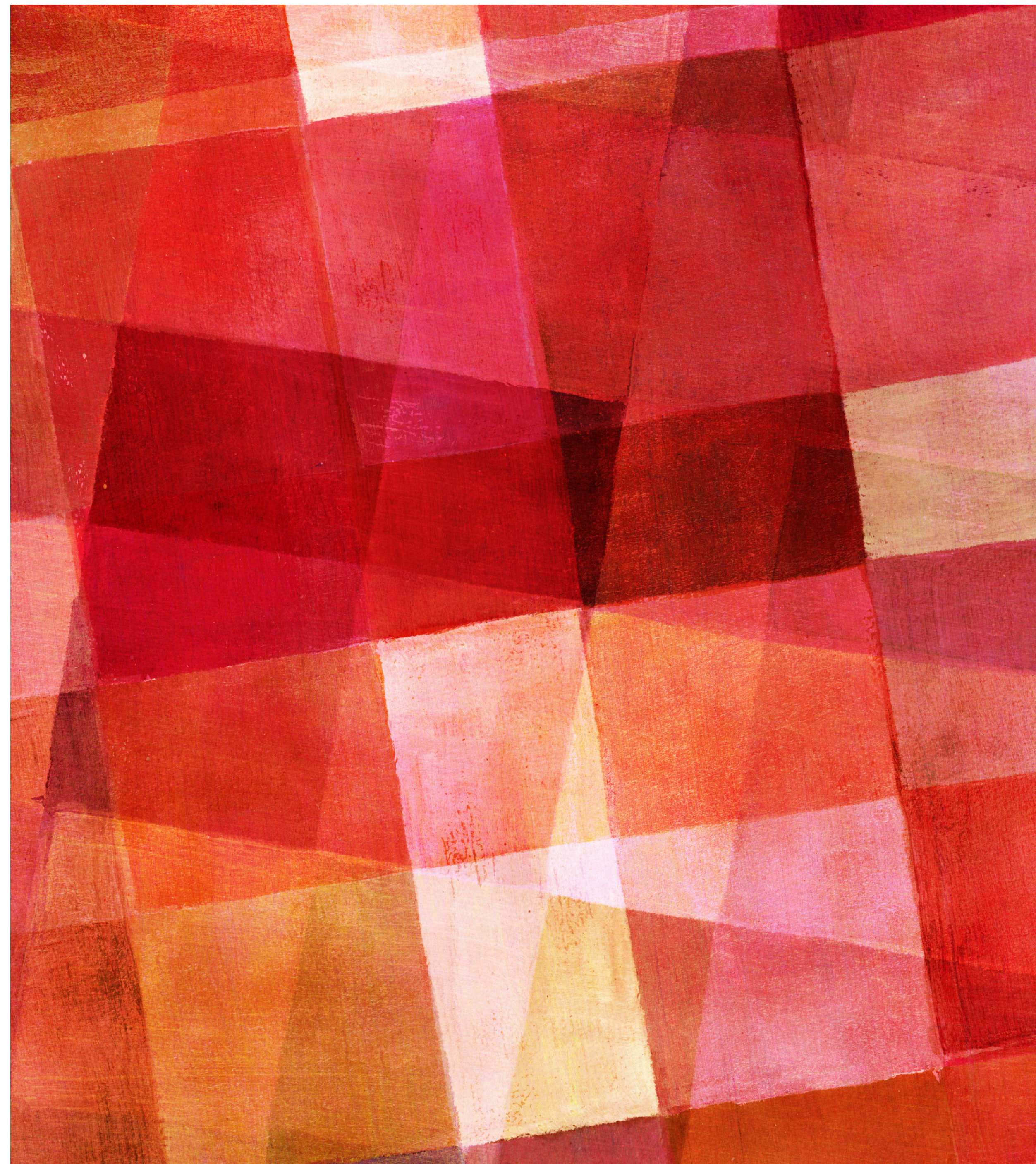

- **Art/ DT:** Tudor structures

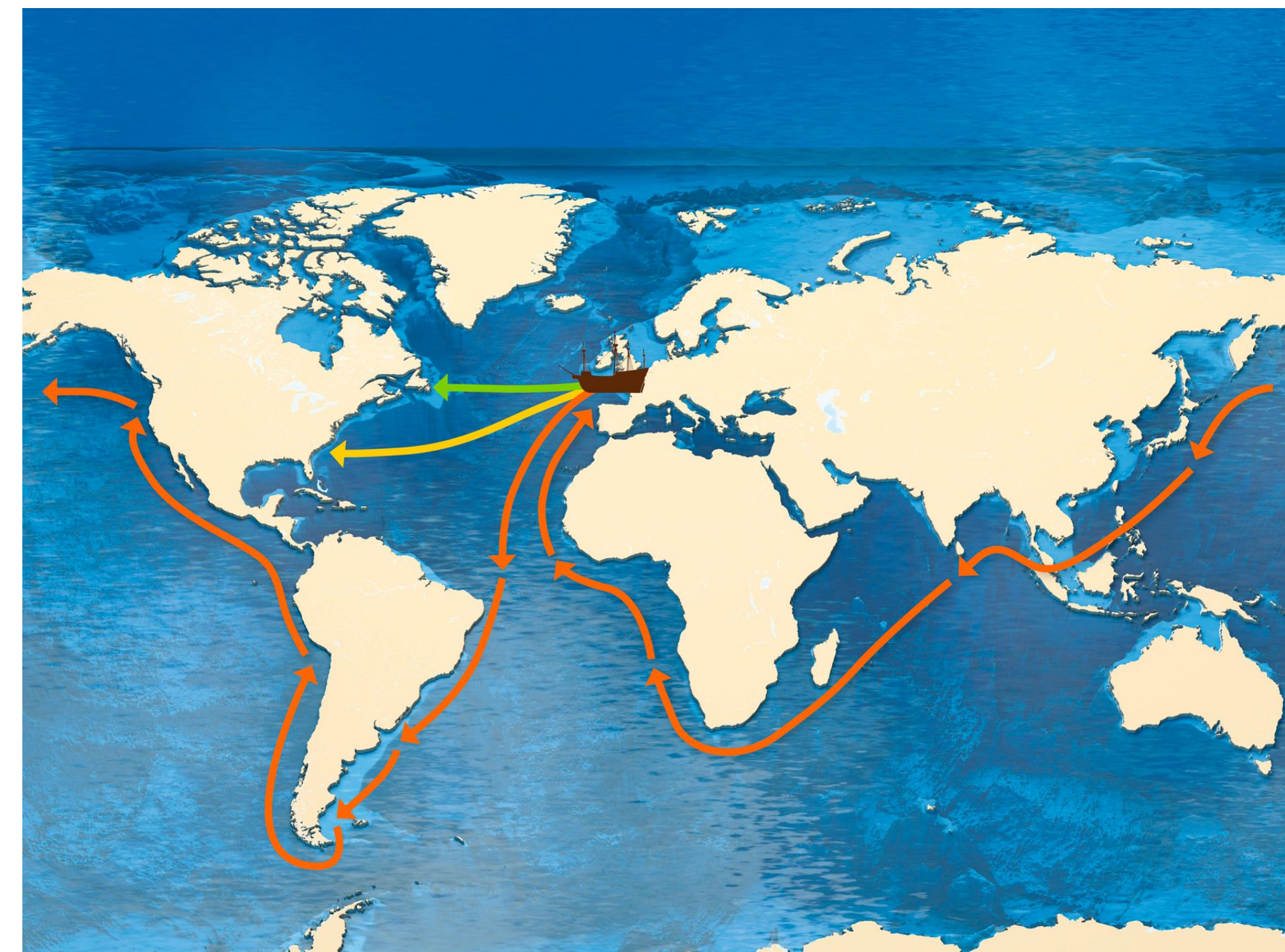
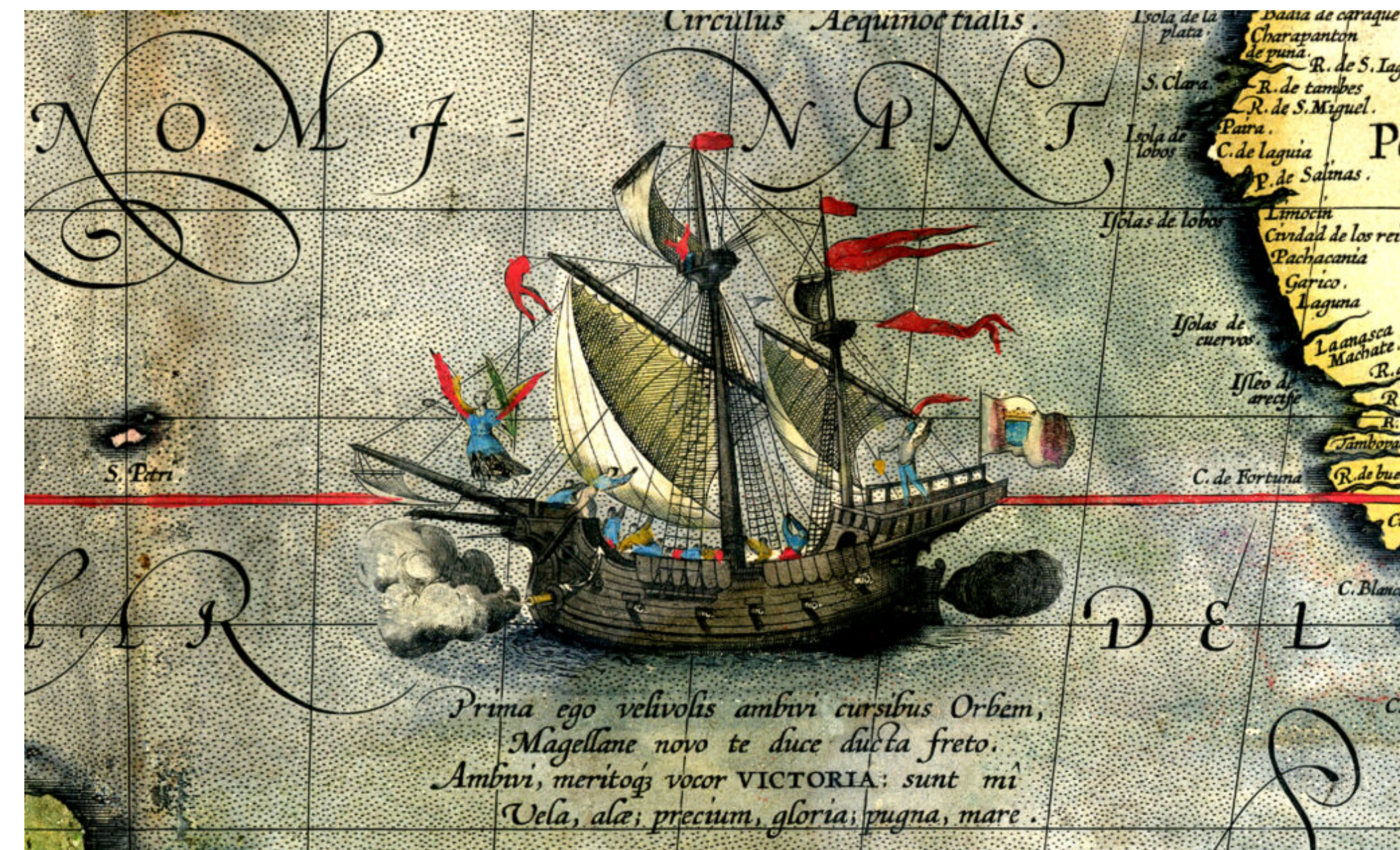

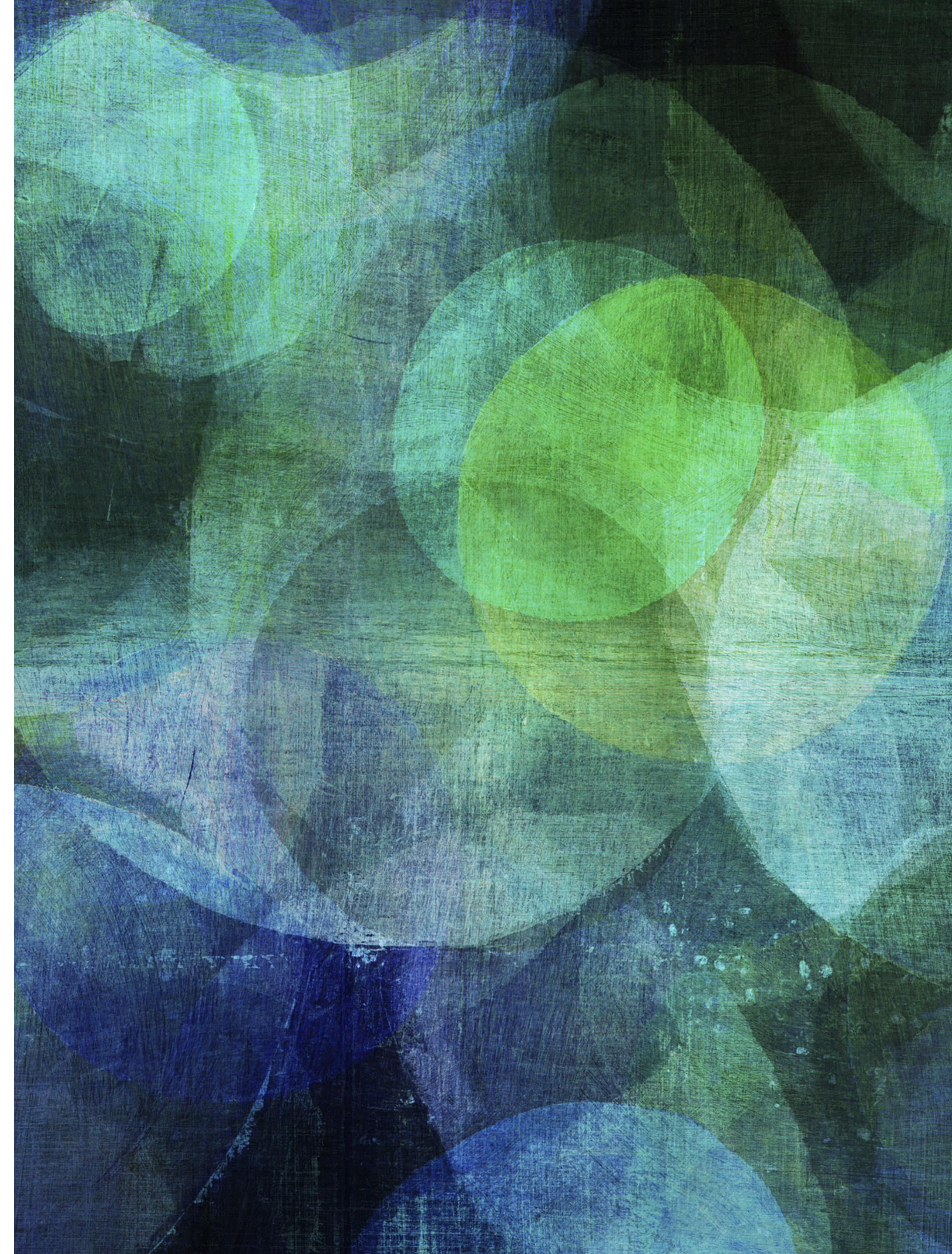
Using the CGP Books to aid with homework

Manageable activities that may vary from week to week could include one or two of the following:

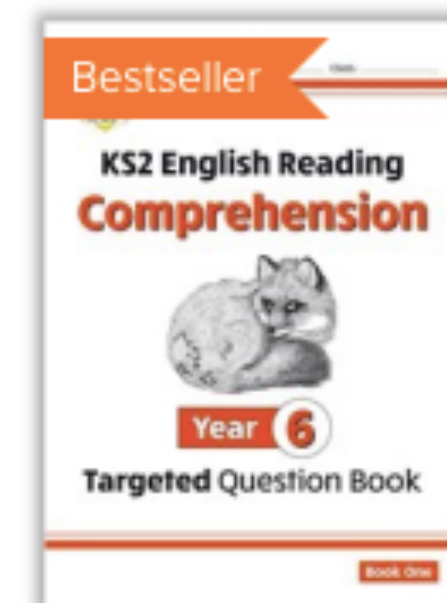
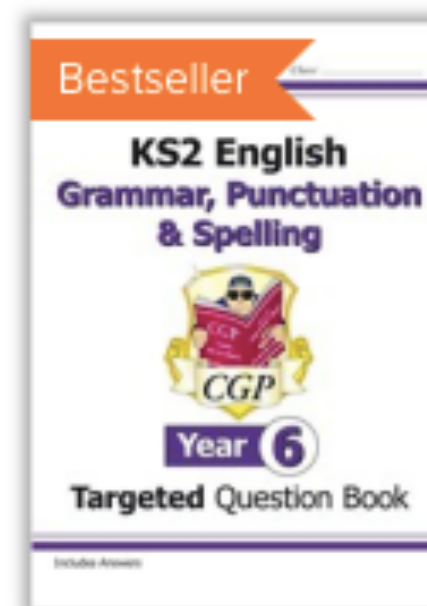
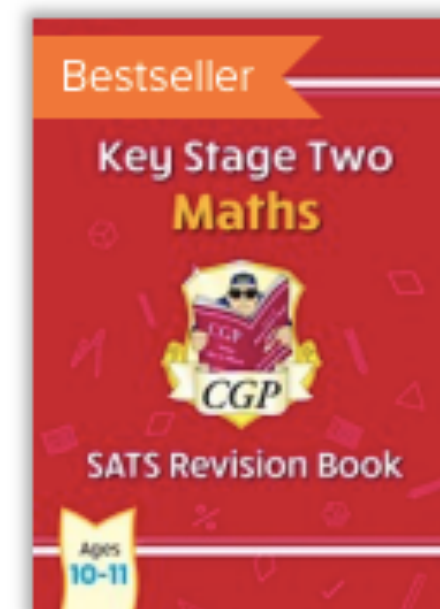
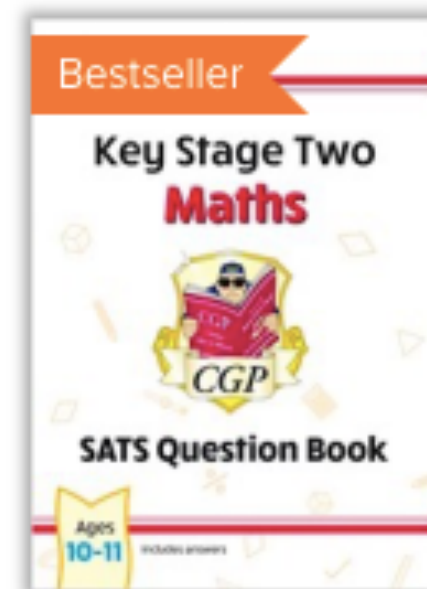
- ✎ Spellings - (following a spelling pattern/ rule; key Year 5/6 spellings)

Homework will not always require the use of the computer

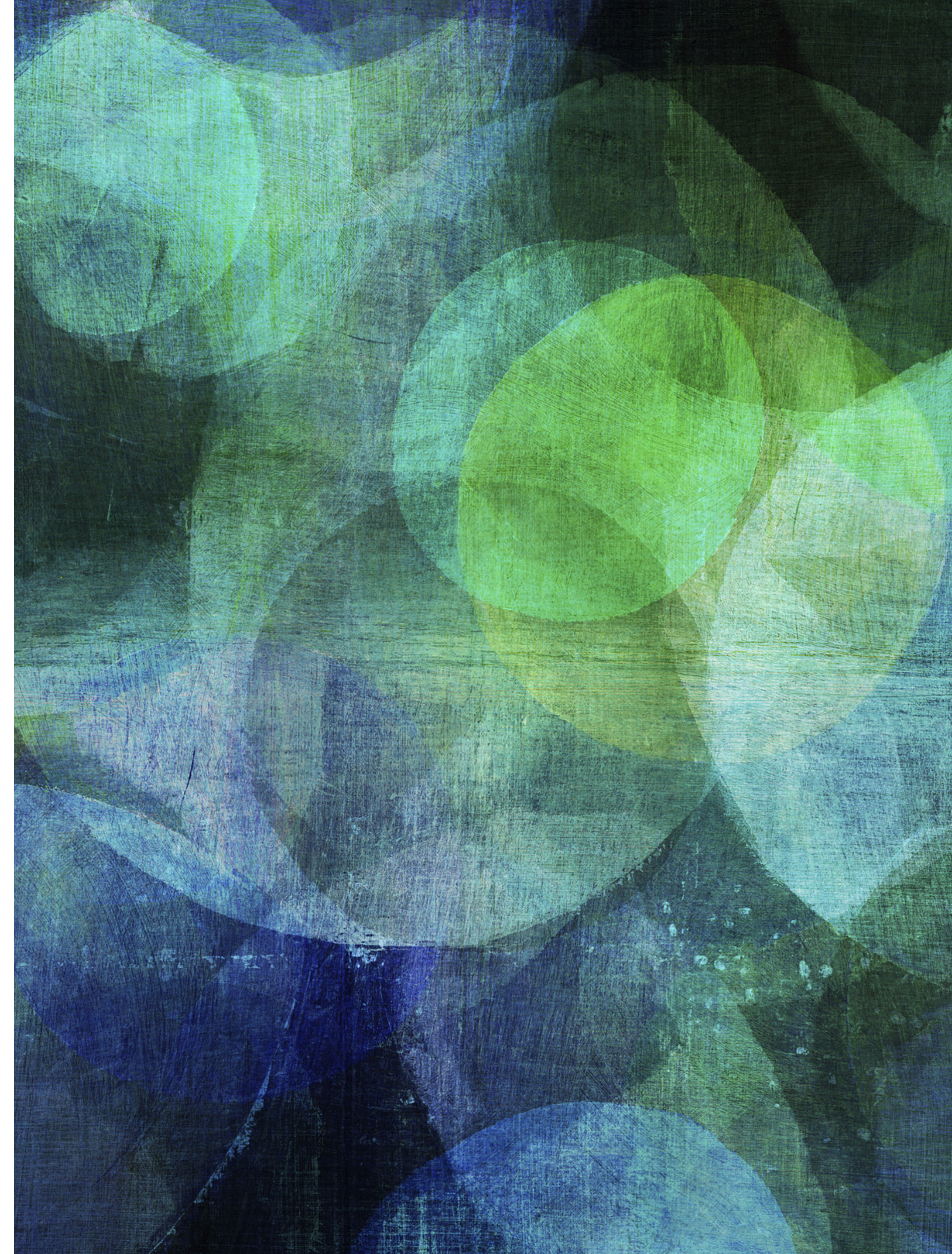

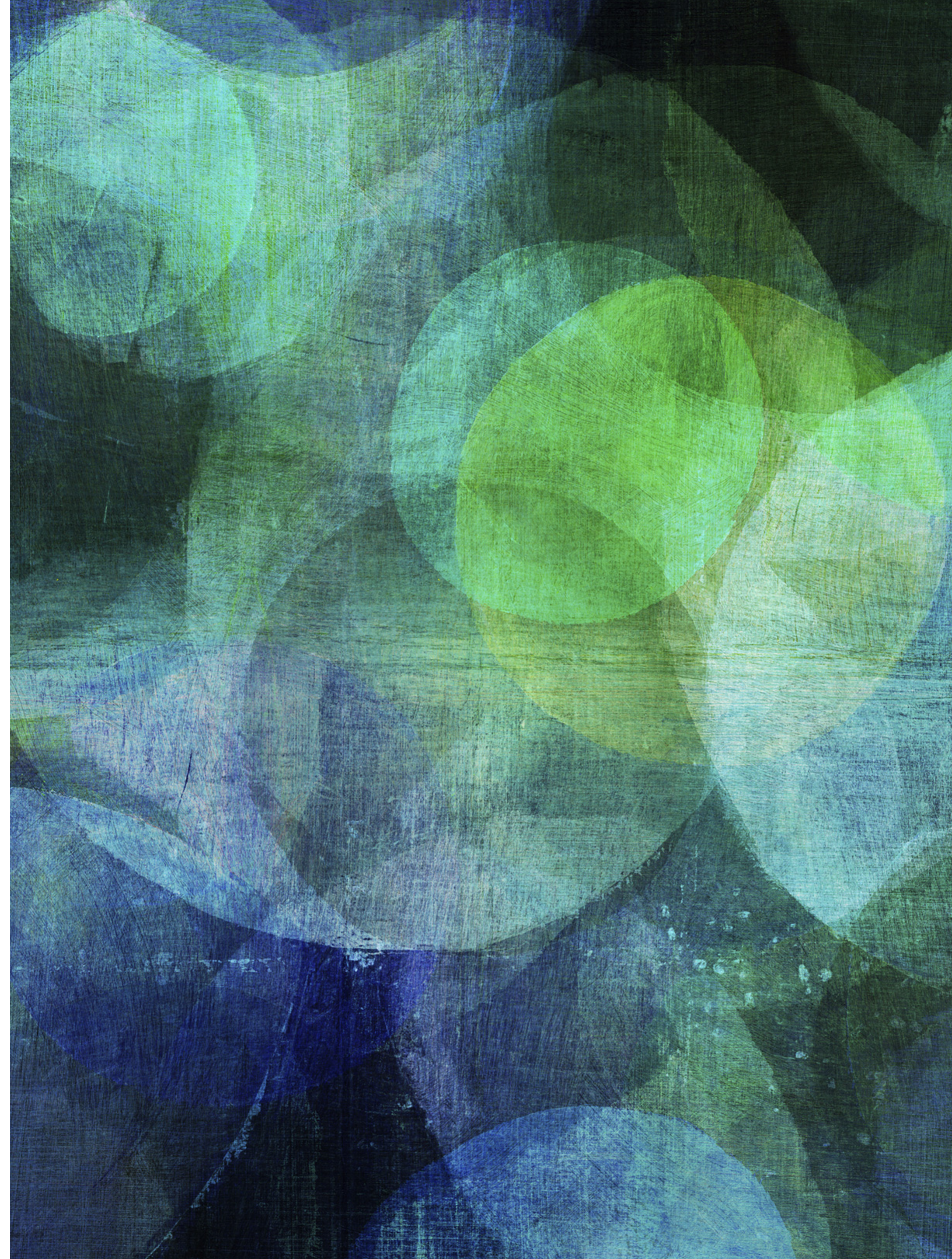
